- As the site is essentially flat, water does tend to pool on the site as drainage is and has been an issue.
- The potential agricultural capability of the site is primarily limited by excess moisture and high groundwater levels. There are also issues associated with access and pre-existing anthropogenic disturbance.

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- The potential for improvements to drainage on the subject property is severely inhibited by the technical issues associated with the ongoing disposal of excess water in an urban area with high groundwater levels.
- The site is not considered to be suitable for cultivation or livestock production and is not currently connected with local or regional agricultural operations.
- Exclusion of the subject property from the ALR is not anticipated to have adverse impacts on surrounding agricultural operations or on local or regional agricultural productive capacity.

Jim Wood, Applicant's Representative:

- Retired teacher who is currently farming various properties within the City.
- Leased the subject property in 1998 for farming purposes, but could not make the property agriculturally viable. Any crops that were planted either died or were not successfully grown.
