### **Guiding Principles**

Where We Started



- Council goals for site redevelopment guiding principles
- Stakeholder vision and design elements
- Consultant team expertise and -"public pencil"





- Maximize site potential and don't underutilize
- Create a cohesive, well-integrated neighborhood
- Address the needs of the community as effectively as possible:
  - Park area, community amenities; e.g. child care, meeting spaces, youth/senior centers, affordable housing, connectivity with surrounding areas





- Complement, rather than compete with surrounding neighborhood and downtown
- Be aware of and capitalize on "demonstration model"
- Manage traffic flows created by the development as well as impact of highway and traffic patterns on the site





- Identify best development process, including site planning, phasing of development and selection of developers & builders
- Create a pedestrian friendly atmosphere
- Set a positive example for developers
- Achieve a positive financial return
- Utilize a multi-bottom line approach and analysis






