SUBJECT:

2008 World Arm Wrestling Championships

RECOMMENDATION:

THAT City Council approve \$5,000 from the Sports Event Development Grant as support towards the 2008 World Arm Wrestling Championships to be held November 29th to December 8th, 2008, at the Delta Grand Okanagan in Kelowna.

BACKGROUND:

The 2008 World Arm Wrestling Championships will be a joint project between the BC Arm Wrestling Association (head office in Kelowna), the Canadian Arm Wrestling Federation and the World Arm Wrestling Federation. Key aspects of the event include:

- Date: November 29th to December 8th
- Location: The Delta Grand Okanagan in Kelowna.
- Attraction: This promises to be one of the largest world championships in arm wrestling history since more than 1,900 participants have applied to compete in Kelowna.
- Sport Tourism Impact: Participants from around the world will visit during a non-peak period and stay for the duration of the event.
- Budget: Balanced budget of ~ \$123,000
- <u>Exposure</u>: The event will be broadcast live on the internet. Plus, with the 2010 Olympic and Paralympic Games around the corner, this world championship gives Kelowna a timely boost in international credibility and exposure.

The City's Sport Event Development Grant Program has been very successful since its development in 2002. The sport of Arm Wrestling becomes a clear example of how this fund can stimulate event growth, support sport development and enhance sport tourism. Through our Sport Kelowna partnership we collaborated with the BC Arm Wrestling Association in hosting the 2006 Provincial Arm Wrestling Championships and 2006 Canadian Arm Wrestling Championships and now the 2008 World Arm Wrestling Championships. The SEDG program has provided funding to both the provincial and national event.

The recommendation follows the City Council approved funding guidelines for the Sport Event Development Grant Program with World Championships able to be funded to a maximum of \$5,000. This recommendation is brought forward on behalf of the SEDG Review Team.

A summary of events that have received funding in 2008 is attached.

The economic impact figure is calculated using a formula provided by Tourism Kelowna. Event organizers provide best estimates of attendance and night-stays which become key factors of this calculation.

The Sport Event Development Grant demonstrates the City's commitment to sport tourism through partnering with local sport associations. Although the S.E.D.G. may not be directly responsible for the events occurring in Kelowna, it provides City resources that encourage event development and enhances the quality of events.
