Project Timeline

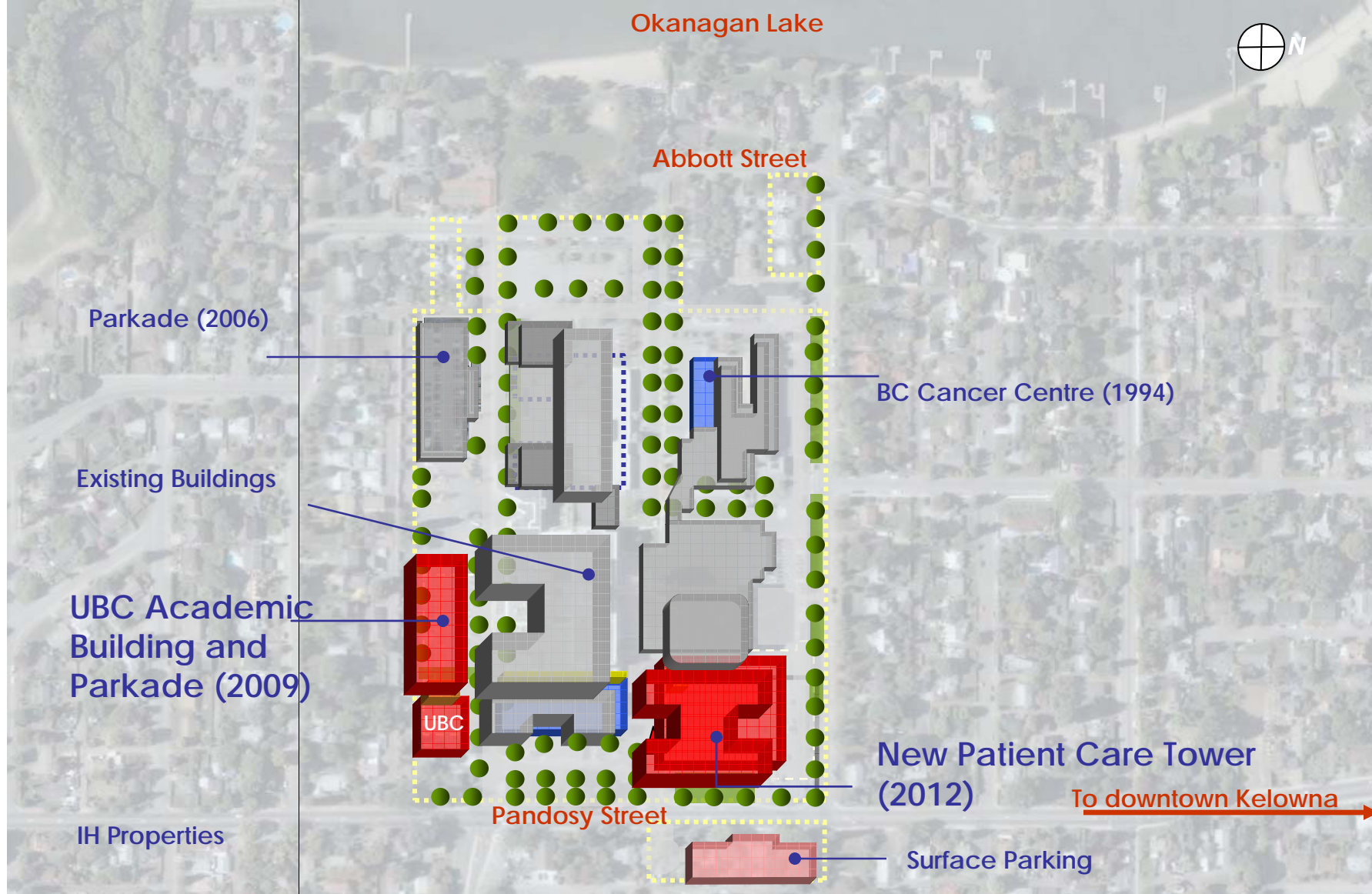
- Kelowna Vernon Hospitals Construction

 - Start Fall 2008 – Completion 2011
 - KGH Patient Care Tower and New ER
 - Pre-loaded Spring 2008 – Removal Winter 2009
 - Construction Start Winter 2009 – Completion 2012
