## RECOMMENDATION:

**THAT** City Council authorize the acquisition of the 5 "Pay and Display" parking meters for the east side of St. Paul Street from Doyle Avenue to Cawston Avenue at a cost of \$9,000 per unit for a total of \$47,250 to be funded from the Parking Reserve;

AND THAT the 2008 financial plan be amended to account for this acquisition from reserve funds.

## **BACKGROUND:**

A petition was received in August, 2008, from Mr. Mike O'Rourke and 12 businesses on the 1300 block of St. Paul Street with the following wording:

"We, the undersigned, hereby petition the City of Kelowna for the following": To place parking meters on St. Paul Street between Doyle Avenue and Cawston Avenue on both sides of the street.

Staff reviewed the petition and agrees that parking meters should be installed along the 1300 block of St. Paul Street but only on the east side at this point and time due to this side being completely urbanized. As new development and construction continues on the west side of St. Paul Street and urbanization occurs staff will implement pay parking on the west side as needed.

A report was generated and brought forward to the Parking Committee on November 13<sup>th</sup> for support (attached as Schedule 'A'). Subsequently the Parking Committee supported the staff recommendation and asked that this report be forwarded to Council requesting the required funding for this project.

Staff is requesting that Council authorize the acquisition of these 5 "Pay and Display" parking meters for the east side of St. Paul Street from Doyle Avenue to Cawston Avenue at a cost of \$9,000 per unit for a total of \$47,250 to be funded from the Parking Reserve and that Council authorize the implementation of pay parking on the west side of the same block as urbanization occurs.



Petition to Implement Pay Parking along the 1300 Block of St. Paul Street

For your information we received a petition dated August 27, 2008 from Mr. Mike O'Rourke and 12 businesses on the 1300 block of St. Paul Street with the following wording:

"We, the undersigned, hereby petition the City of Kelowna for the following": To place parking meters on St. Paul Street between Doyle Avenue and Cawston Avenue on both sides of the street.

Staff has reviewed the petition and agrees that parking meters should be installed along the 1300 block of St. Paul Street but only on the east side at this point and time due to this side being completely urbanized. As new development and construction continues on the west side of St. Paul Street and urbanization occurs staff will implement pay parking on the west side as requested.

Staff will be submitting a budget amendment to City Council in the near future to request the required \$50,000 for the purchase of 5 pay and display parking meters for the east side of St. Paul Street and will budget the remaining cost in 2009 for the west side of the 1300 Block of St. Paul Street.
