    - Laurel Building Upgrade \$3.4M
    - Other for consideration, if funding is available
      - Hwy 33 4 laning (Muir to Gallagher) \$24m
      - Hall Road Sewer \$11M
      - Gordon Dr Bridge and 4 laning 12.5M
- Advised that these are projects that staff feel they can deliver in 2009.
- Confirmed that the entire Hall Road area is currently on a septic field.
- Advised that the Hall Road area is the next on staff's priority list for sewer, but it is likely that staff cannot deal with the matter until late 2009, early 2010.
- Confirmed that the City of Kelowna does not put funds towards a sewer spec area.
  The City only upgrades the infrastructure in the area (sidewalks, roads, drainage etc.)
- Advised that any DCC funding for Gordon Drive or Highway 33 would have to be borrowed as the funds are not readily available.
- Advised that the designs for Gordon Drive and Highway 33 are virtually complete.
