Re: Support for Kelowna's Ten-Year Plan to End Homelessness

Thanks in no small part to the impetus created by your November 2007 Event to End Homelessness, the development of Kelowna's Ten-Year Plan to End Homelessness is now well underway. The initial research and planning phase is complete and the plan's framework is being finalized by the Kelowna Committee to End Homelessness and the consultant team.

Initial funding from Service Canada, BC Housing and a private contribution have made it possible to initiate the planning process and complete this important first phase. The City of Kelowna has also been generous with advice and with in-kind web support for the community affordability survey – a key component of both the research and community consultation phases of this important project.

In order for this process to reflect best practices and be truly community-driven, the Committee has requested that funding be sought to expand the community consultation component and to invest additional research and consultation time in the development of the plan. The addition of a transitional phase to implementation must also be included.

This is an opportunity for the City of Kelowna to reaffirm its commitment to the Ten-Year Plan and to demonstrate its support for the community initiative that is currently underway. The City of Kelowna is a key stakeholder in this undertaking and an essential participant in the success of the plan.

On behalf of the Kelowna Committee to End Homelessness, we are making this request to the City of Kelowna for a contribution of \$17,000 to support the development of the plan and to represent the City's commitment to its successful completion and implementation. We believe that like other local governments in Canadian communities where similar plans have been undertaken, the City of Kelowna will want to be seen to be an active and willing supporter of this critical process.
