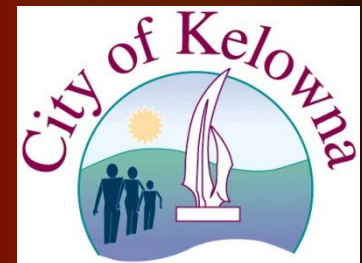

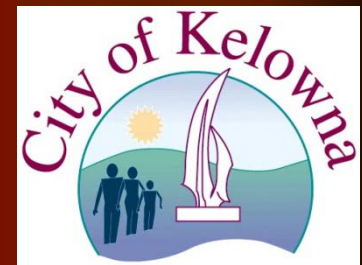

Awarded to the amateur or professional team that has brought the greatest amount of recognition to Kelowna.

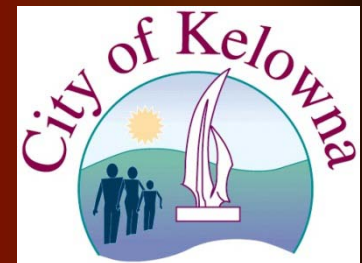

Awarded to the female athlete, amateur or professional that has brought the greatest amount of recognition to Kelowna.

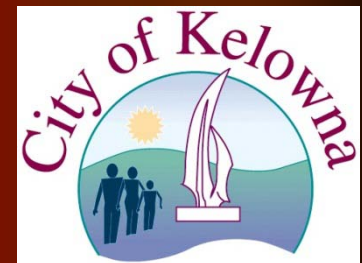

Awarded to the male athlete, amateur or professional that has brought the greatest amount of recognition to Kelowna

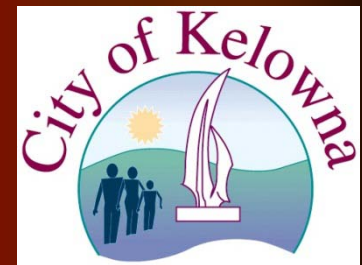

Awarded to the young female citizen who has made an outstanding contribution through voluntary service to their community and school.

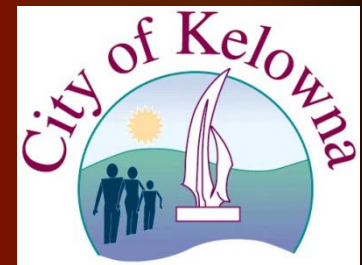

Awarded to the young male citizen who has made an outstanding contribution through voluntary service to their community and school.

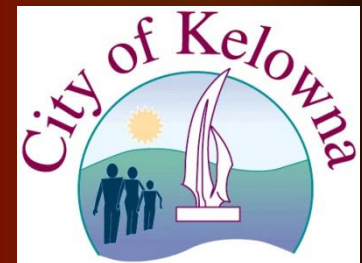

Awarded to the student who has made an outstanding contribution to their community and school's cultural and/or artistic life.

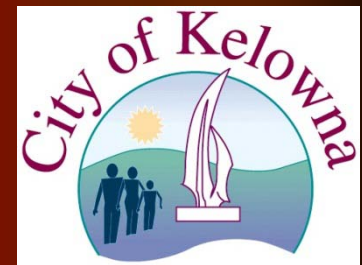

Awarded to an individual who has made an outstanding contribution in Kelowna through cultural and/or artistic efforts.

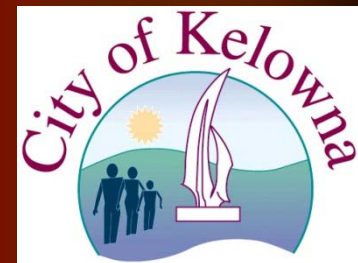

Awarded to the not-for-profit organization that has provided overall outstanding community service, having had a direct benefit on the residents in Kelowna.

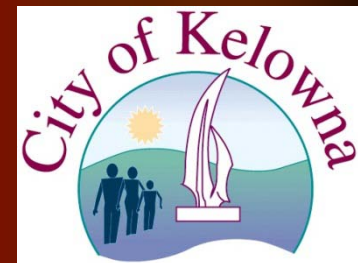

Awarded to a women in recognition of her overall outstanding contributions through voluntary service to the well-being of the City of Kelowna.

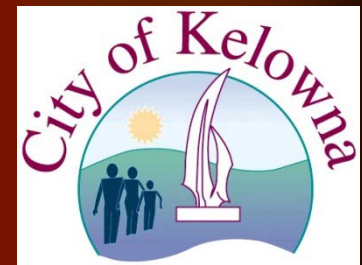

Awarded to a man in recognition of his overall outstanding contributions through voluntary service to the well-being of the City of Kelowna.

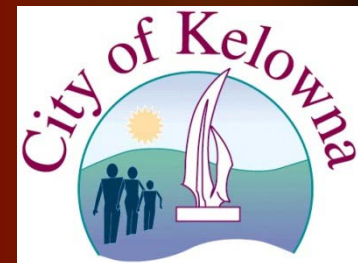
