Shane Worman, Worman Resources Inc., Applicant's Representative

- Believes that the area in the laneway that is designated for loading and off-loading would accommodate the size of the trucks.

Gallery:

Mary Jane Addison, 2678 Gore Street

- Advised that the dumpster in the back laneway is currently being used by other commercial merchants in the area and wanted to know what was being proposed for this development.

Maryann Ingraham, 2627 Gore Street

- Because Gore Street is a dead-end, she is concerned that vehicles will need to travel to the end of the street in order to turn around so that they leave the area.

Doug Ingraham, 2627 Gore Street

- Believes that the parking issues can be dealt with if the design/footprint of the building is changed.
- Does not believe that there is adequate parking for the development, especially for the commercial component.
- Believes that the design of the building is "institutional".

Shane Worman, Worman Resources Inc., Applicant's Representative
 Advised that there will be three (3) roll out bins provided for the commercial component of the development (1 for garbage; 1 for recycling; 1 for yard waste).

Would be willing to request that commercial operators encourage their employees to use the Osprey parking lot for their employee parking.
