Subject: Award of contract T10-022 Asphalt overlay / Mill & Fill 2010

Recommendation:

THAT Council award the Contract for the 2010 Asphalt Overlay / Mill & Fill work to Emil Anderson Construction (EAC) Inc., for the amount of \$ 781,709.75, which includes GST

AND THAT the Mayor and City Clerk be authorized to execute this Contract on behalf of the City.

Background:

The work that will be performed in this Contract is a portion of the City's annual Road Resurfacing Program. The Resurfacing Program is intended to maintain or improve the existing traveled asphalt surface conditions throughout the City. The roads to be paved are determined by our Pavement Management System which consists of data collection that is inserted in computer software which leads to a cost-benefit analysis, and ultimately the prioritization of the streets that need improvement. The list of roads to be paved through this Contract is attached.

In response to our recent invitation to Tender (Asphalt Overlay / Mill & Fill Tender T10-022), three bids were received. A summary of the bids received, with GST included, is shown below:

Emil Anderson Construction (EAC) Inc.	\$ 781,709.75
Peters Bros. Construction Ltd.	\$ 1,017,640.32
Westlake Paving and Aggregate Ltd.	\$ 844,886.99

The bids have been reviewed for accuracy and errors. Emil Anderson Construction (EAC) Inc. has complied with the tender documents, and included the specified Bid Bond and Surety Consent for Performance and Labour and Material Payment bonds.

Upon award, construction of the work included in this Contract is anticipated to begin in May with completion in August 2010.
