FREQUENCY OF INSPECTION MANDATE

RECOMMENDATION:

THAT Council approve amendments to Council Policy 181 regarding the frequency of fire inspections for buildings in the City of Kelowna.

BACKGROUND:

The Fire Services Act stipulates that a municipal council must provide for a regular system of inspection by an officer of buildings in the municipality. Inspection frequencies performed by the Kelowna Fire Department have not been reviewed for a number of years. The current inspection frequency policy was developed at a time when the Office of the Fire Commissioner (OFC) was involved in recommending inspection frequencies across the province. It has been determined that these are not achievable, nor are they reasonable given periods of high growth, the availability of resources and the level of associated risk.

Adjusting inspection frequencies will allow the Kelowna Fire Department to focus on buildings such as restaurants, industrial workshops, care homes and daycares, all considered high risk occupancies, while reducing the frequency of inspections on all lower risk properties and occupancies. This revision, combined with increased company inspections currently performed by the second company working out of Station 1, and engine companies at halls 2, 3 and 4, will assist in meeting the inspection frequency policy. Engine company inspections are balanced with increasing calls for service and ongoing training and hall duties.

Over the past 3 years, the Inspections Branch has only been able to achieve approximately 40% of the inspection frequency as per policy. The revised policy will reduce inspections from 6,443 annually (9,650 hours) to 4,440 annually (7,150 hours). We believe this is an achievable standard and provides a comparable best practice relative to other fire services in the province.

The attached Appendix "A" details the changes in inspection frequency between the existing policy and the recommended policy.
