RECOMMENDATION:

THAT Council award the Contract for the 2010 Asphalt Paving work to Peters Bros. Construction Ltd., for the amount of \$ 778,235.85 (SEVEN HUNDRED SEVENTY EIGHT THOUSAND TWO HUNDRED AND THIRTY FIVE Dollars and Eighty Five Cents) including GST; AND

THAT the Mayor and City Clerk be authorized to execute the Contract on behalf of the City.

BACKGROUND:

This contract is the second of two Asphalt Paving contracts for the 2010 Construction Season. The work contained in this Contract is a portion of the City's annual Road Resurfacing Program. The Resurfacing Program is intended to maintain or improve the current traveled asphalt surface conditions throughout the City. The roads to be paved are selected through our Pavement Management System which consists of data collection and computer software which allows for cost-benefit analysis. The list of roads to be paved through this Contract is attached.

In response to our recent invitation to Tender (Paving Tender T10-039), on April 8, 2010 three bids were received. A summary of the bids received, with GST included, is shown below:

Peters Bros. Construction Ltd.	\$ 778,235.85
Emil Anderson Construction (EAC) Inc.	\$ 780,178.56
Westlake Paving and Aggregate Ltd.	\$ 950,706.33

The bids have been reviewed for accuracy and errors. Peters Bros. Construction Ltd., has complied with the tender documents, and included the specified Bid Bond and Surety Consent for Performance and Labour and Material Payment bonds.

Upon award, construction of this project is anticipated to begin in May with completion in September 2010.
