BYLAW NO. 10338

Sale of City-Owned Land Reserve Fund Expenditure Bylaw, 2010

WHEREAS, there is an unappropriated balance in the Sale of City-Owned Land Reserve Fund of Eight Million, Two Hundred and Fifty-Four Thousand, Six Hundred and Sixty-Five Dollars (\$8, 254,665.00) as at January 1st, 2010.

AND WHEREAS, it is deemed desirable to expend a portion of the monies set aside under said Sale of City-Owned Land Reserve Fund for the purpose of land purchases and enhancements set out below;

NOW THEREFORE, the Municipal Council of the City of Kelowna, in open meeting assembled, enacts as follows:

1. The sum of Eight Million, Two Hundred and Fifty-Four Thousand, Six Hundred and Sixty-Five Dollars (\$8, 254,665.00) as at January 1st, 2010 is hereby appropriated from the Sale of City-Owned Land Reserve Fund to be expended in 2010 for the following purposes:

 General Land Acquisition
 \$ 3,432,226.00

 Parks
 \$ 3,459,624.00

 Housing Opportunity
 \$ 1,362,815.00

\$8,254,665.00

- 2. The expenditure to be carried out by the monies hereby appropriated shall be more particularly specified and authorized by resolution of Council.
- 3. Should any of the above remain unexpended after the expenditures hereby authorized have been made, the unexpended balance shall be returned to the credit of the City-Owned Land Reserve Fund.
- 4. This bylaw may be cited as the "Sale of City-Owned Land Reserve Fund Expenditure Bylaw, 2010, No. 10338".
