

CITY OF KELOWNA
BYLAW NO. 10365
Amendment No. 36 to the Water Regulation Bylaw No. 2173

The Municipal Council of the City of Kelowna, in open meeting assembled, enacts that the City of Kelowna Water Regulation Bylaw No. 2173 be amended as follows:

1. THAT **Section 28 - Rates and Charges, sub-paragraph (i) Hydrant Use** be deleted in its entirety and replaced with the following:

“(i) Hydrant Use

 - (i) Effective with the April 16, 2010 billing, a flat rate charge of \$60.00 plus applicable taxes for a Hydrant Use Permit.
 - (ii) The cost for a Hydrant Use permit shall be \$25 per day, plus applicable taxes. This fee shall cover the costs of providing backflow preventers, the installation and removal of backflow preventers, the servicing of a hydrant after its use, and associated administrative costs.”
- 2.. This bylaw shall be cited as Bylaw No. 10365 – Amendment No. 36 to Water Regulation Bylaw No. 2173
3. This bylaw will come into full force and be binding on all persons as from the date of adoption.
