Purpose: To provide consistency between the proposed increase in the Municipal Ticket Information fines and the Noise Bylaw maximum fine amount.


Background:

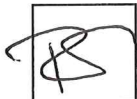
