6. ADDITION TO THE AGENDA

6.1 Director, Land Use Management, re: <u>Liquor License Application - Departures Terminal at the Kelowna International Airport - Skyway Lounge - Notification of Abutting Property Owners</u>

Staff:

- Due to recent regulatory changes in the pre-board screening process, structural changes are required to the Departures Terminal at the Kelowna International Airport, which affects the floor plan for the Skyway Lounge. This will mean an increase in the licensed area capacity of an additional 26 seats.
- To streamline this process, it is hoped that the typical notification process, as per Council Policy No. 315, could be amended for this particular application, for the following reasons:
 - The additional person capacity is very limited (26 persons);
 - o This is located within a secure area of the Airport;
 - There are no impacts to public safety; and
 - o The typical requirement to mail-out to property owners within a 400m radius would be very onerous given the application, and would be an unwarranted expense.
- The proposed notification process would be conventional newspaper advertisements and signage as per the normal Regular Meeting requirements, with no individual mail-out.
