Recommendation:

THAT Bylaw No. 10452, being Amendment No. 25 to the City of Kelowna Electricity Regulation Bylaw No. 7639 be forwarded for reading consideration.

Purpose:

To adjust the Electrical rates bylaw to reflect appropriate rates based on the last bylaw change.

Background:

The last electrical rate bylaw had incorrect rates for five electrical rate codes. The five rate codes were referencing back to an earlier bylaw and did not get adjusted appropriately for the last rate increase. The reference tables have been adjusted to avoid this issue for any future rate changes. There is minimal financial impact for the one month billing differential as these were mainly for City of Kelowna properties.
