1.0 Recommendation

THAT in accordance with Development Application Procedures Bylaw No. 8140 the deadline for the adoption of Official Community Plan Amendment No. OCP07-0022 Bylaw No. 10265 - Al Stober Construction Ltd. (Meiklejohn Architecture Inc.) - 477 Osprey Avenue and Zone Amending Bylaw No. 10266 (Z07-0073) - Al Stober Construction Ltd. (Meiklejohn Architecture Inc.) - 477 Osprey Avenue be extended from December 15, 2010 to June 15, 2011.

2.0 Summary

The above noted development application was originally considered at a Public Hearing by Council on December 15, 2009.

Section 2.10.1 of Procedure Bylaw No. 8140 states that:

Every amendment bylaw which has not been finally adopted by Council within 12 months after the date it was given third reading, lapses and will be of no force and effect, and an applicant who wishes to proceed with its application must initiate a new application.

Section 2.10.2 of the Procedure Bylaw makes provision for Council to consider an extension to an amending bylaw for up to 6 months beyond the 12 months deadline as stated in Section 2.10.1.

The applicant has made this application for rezoning to allow the subject property to be consolidated with the adjacent property (former Liquidation World building). The applicants propose to develop the consolidated site with a seven storey, mixed-use development of grade level retail, five storeys of office uses, and a storey of apartment housing.



The Official Community Plan amendment bylaw #10265 and the zone amending bylaw No. 10266 received second and third readings on December 15, 2009, after the Public Hearing held on the same date.

The applicant wishes to have this application remain open in order to provide more time to resolve the outstanding servicing issues.
