Mayor Shepherd & Council:

This report contains recommendations for 2011 Arts, Culture & Heritage Grants and the 2011 Community Festivals, Events & Project Grants to be presented to Council on February 7, 2011.

The following information will provide some useful background about how the recommendations were formulated.

In 2010 a Memorandum of Understanding was created between the City of Kelowna, Cultural Services Branch (CSB) and the Central Okanagan Foundation (COF). To ensure continued success in administration of the Arts Culture and Heritage "Operating" grants and the Community Festivals, Events & Project (Project) grants the Memorandum of Understanding is revisited and amended on a yearly basis.

The Cultural Services Branch and Central Okanagan Foundation reviewed the submitted applications for the Operating and Project grants to determine enough information was in the application for the Grants Advisory committee to make informed and responsible decisions. If minor gaps were identified, the Cultural Services Branch staff contacted the applicant organization to offer them an opportunity to fill in the gaps and / or answer questions.

In consultation with the Cultural Services Branch, the Central Okanagan Foundation formed two Grants Advisory committees (one per program) each consisting of six to eight, qualified volunteers, one member recruited from out of the Central Okanagan to adjudicate the grant applications and make recommendations for grant awards.

An orientation session for each Grants Advisory committee member was conducted and a manual consisting of a copy of the grant application and guidelines, Terms of Reference, and steps outlining the process and how the grants are to be evaluated was provided.

Each Committee member was given an evaluation package containing an agenda, evaluation tool and vetted applications for review.

Central Okanagan Foundation chaired the Operating and Project grant committees separately. The committees reviewed each application as a group and formulated recommendations for grant awards.

Minutes from the Grants Advisory committee meeting were prepared by the Central Okanagan Foundation for distribution and approval by the Grants Advisory committee members.

Upon the committee member's approval of the minutes, the Central Okanagan Foundation prepared a report to Council containing the Grants Advisory committees' recommendations.
