On January 31, 2011 Council adopted a new bylaw, Bylaw Notice Enforcement Bylaw which allows for a new order of enforcement for minor bylaw infractions. This bylaw was created by staff in order to proceed with the provisions of the Bylaw Dispute Adjudication System as directed by Council in September 2009.

Recently it has come to staffs attention a few minor formatting discrepancies with wording and fines in a few of the sections in Schedule "A" of the bylaw. Therefore, staff wishes to present an amending bylaw to correct these discrepancies and ensure the bylaw is accurate.
