

Dear Mayor Shepherd & Council:

This report contains recommendations for the 2011 City of Kelowna, Community Social Development Grants, and Grants to Address the Sexual Exploitation of Youth to be presented to City of Kelowna Council on April 4, 2011.

A total of eighteen grant applications were received, fourteen for the Community Social Development grants program and two for the Grants to Address the Sexual Exploitation of Youth program. Two applications were ineligible. There is \$80,000.00 available to fund and the total amount requested for Community Social Development grants is \$115,642.00. The amount requested for Grants to Address the Sexual Exploitation of Youth is \$24,450.00 with \$22,000.00 available to fund.

The City of Kelowna / Central Okanagan Foundation Advisory committee is recommending the approval of the following grant applications from their meeting on March 22, 2011:
