1.0 Recommendation

THAT in accordance with Development Application Procedures Bylaw No. 8140, the deadline for the adoption of Zone Amending Bylaw No10330 (Z10-0018, Sarabjit & Kuldip Buttar (Axel Hilmer) 729 Renshaw Road), be extended from May 18, 2011 to November 18, 2011.

2.0 **Purpose**

The application seeks to rezone the subject property from the RU1 - Large Lot Housing zone to the RU1s - Large Lot Housing with a secondary suite zone to legalize a secondary suite within a single family dwelling.

3.0 Land Use Management

The above noted development application was originally considered at a Public Hearing by Council on May 18, 2010.

Section 2.10.1 of Procedure Bylaw No. 8140 states that:

Every amendment bylaw which has not been finally adopted by Council within 12 months after the date it was given third reading, lapses and will be of no force and effect, and an applicant who wishes to proceed with its application must initiate a new application.

Section 2.10.2 of the Procedure Bylaw makes provision for Council to consider an extension to an amending bylaw for up to 6 months beyond the 12 months deadline as stated in Section 2.10.1.

Bylaw No. 10330 received second and third readings on May 18, 2010 after the Public Hearing held on the same date. The applicant wishes to have this application remain open for an

additional six months in order to complete the recommendations for final adoption. This project remains unchanged and is the same in all respects as originally applied for.

The Land Use Management Department recommends Council consider the request for an extension favourably.


