BYLAW NO. 10532

Sale of City-Owned Land Reserve Fund Expenditure Bylaw, 2011

WHEREAS, there is an unappropriated balance in the Sale of City-Owned Land Reserve Fund of Seven Million, Six Hundred and Twenty-Nine Thousand, Eight Hundred and Ninety-Two Dollars (\$7,629,892.00) as at January 1st, 2011.

AND WHEREAS, it is deemed desirable to expend a portion of the monies set aside under said Sale of City-Owned Land Reserve Fund for the purpose of land purchases and enhancements set out below;

NOW THEREFORE, the Municipal Council of the City of Kelowna, in open meeting assembled, enacts as follows:

1. The sum of Seven Million, Six Hundred and Twenty-Nine Thousand, Eight Hundred and Ninety-Two Dollars (\$7,629,892.00) as at January 1st, 2011 is hereby appropriated from the Sale of City-Owned Land Reserve Fund to be expended in 2011 for the following purposes:

General Land Acquisition	\$ 3,893,808.00
Parks Land .	\$ 2,444,297.00
Housing Opportunity	\$ 1,291,787.00

\$7,629,892.00

- 2. The expenditure to be carried out by the monies hereby appropriated shall be more particularly specified and authorized by resolution of Council.
- 3. Should any of the above remain unexpended after the expenditures hereby authorized have been made, the unexpended balance shall be returned to the credit of the City-Owned Land Reserve Fund.
- 4. This bylaw may be cited as the "Sale of City-Owned Land Reserve Fund Expenditure Bylaw, 2011, No. 10532".
