AND FURTHER THAT the Mayor and City Clerk be authorized to execute the License of Occupation Agreements and all documents associated with this transaction.

Purpose:

To enter into five (5) year Licenses of Occupation with Enterprise Auto & RV Ltd. and Trailermaster Inc. for the purpose of RV storage.

Background:

A routine examination of roadways near the Old Vernon Road and Rutland Road intersection revealed an unauthorized use of public road by two commercial RV operators. The road is a severed section of the former Highway 97 alignment and dead ends at the entrance of Enterprise RV & Auto Ltd.

Annual license fees are assessed to Enterprise RV & Auto Ltd. and Trailermaster Inc. at \$306.40 and \$377.07 respectively, and represent market rates. The attached plan defines the license areas and are outlined in red, with a minimum 33 foot width driveway maintained for access and egress. The licenses may be renewed for one further five (5) year term at the City's sole discretion.
