THAT in accordance with Development Application Procedures Bylaw No. 10540, the deadline for the adoption of Development Permit Application DP10-0099 (Lot A Section 23 Township 28 SDYD Plan KAP80574, located at 5300 Main St, Kelowna, BC) be extended from September 20, 2011 to March 20, 2012.

Land Use Management

Council considered and supported the Development Permit application at the regular Council meeting of September 20, 2010.

Section 2.12.1 and 2.12.2 of Procedure Bylaw No. 10540 states that:

Renewal and extension of development permits that have been authorized for issuance or have been issued provided:

- (i) The term of authorization for issuance of the Development Permit does not exceed 12 months for the original date of authorization for issuance of the Development Permit; and
- (ii) The term of issuance of the Development Permit does not exceed 2 years from the original date of issuance of the Development Permit.
- Upon written request by the applicant prior to the lapse of the application, (iii) Council may extend the deadline for a period of six (6) months by passing a resolution to that affect.

The Land Use Management Department recognizes that the marketplace is in a unique economic climate at this time, and this may influence the viability of some in-stream development projects. Accordingly, the applicant wishes to have this application remain open for an additional six months.


