OUTDOOR EVENTS

- 2 FT Coordinators that manage the process
- Outdoor Event Committee
 - Multiple City departments and external agencies
 - The Role- Application, consultation, approval, monitoring and evaluation
 - Managing the balance between event requests and community access
 - Filming requests & permits



OUTDOOR EVENTS

- Considerations when reviewing a request:
 - # of park closures
 - # of liquor licenses
 - Impact on park infrastructure
 - Road closures
 - Impact on adjacent residents & businesses
 - Restricted access to parks
 - Impact on City resources
 - Impact on existing events

CULTURAL SERVICES PROJECT GRANTS

- Supports new or existing events with an arts/culture/heritage focus
- \$70,000 available annually via application
- Maximum of \$10,000 per application
- Eligibility expires after 3 consecutive years
- 2012 program:
 - ▶ 17 recipients
 - 9 of 24 applicants were new
 - \$70,000 awarded



SPORT GRANTS

- Sport Event Development Grant
 - Stimulus for the development of new sport events with a sport tourism focus
 - \$35,000 annually
 - ▶ 2011 Summary
 - 27 events funded
 - Allocation \$36,800
 - Estimated economic impact of \$6 million



FESTIVALS KELOWNA

- Non profit society
- City contributes \$248,500 annually
- Contracted to deliver
 - Canada Day
 - Parks Alive!
 - Arts Alive
 - Buskers
- Supports event development and delivery for other agencies such as DKA
- Contract expires December 2012



SUPPORT FOR SPECIAL EVENTS

- Unique (one-of) opportunities that require leadership and City involvement
 - Examples:
 - 2010 Olympic Torch Relay
 - 2010 BreakOut West
 - 2008 BC Summer Games
 - 2011 International Children's Games
 - 2011 BC Dragoons Centennial
- Financial support will vary between events



CHANGING LANDSCAPE...

- Increasing regulatory requirements
 - ▶ i.e. BC Safety Authority, WorkSafe BC, BC LCLB, City
- Expectations of the City by the Event Rights Holder
 - Financial (cash or in-kind) support from the municipality
- Competition with other municipalities
- The cost of putting on an event / absorbing event related support costs - who pays
- Copy-cat nature of events
- Increasing expectations from public (bigger ... better)



CHALLENGES...

- Reputation as event friendly
- City's role in bringing events to Kelowna
- Growing expectations from event organizers but also downloading consequences onto event organizers
- Balance of park closures and public access



CHALLENGES

- Managing event spillover into downtown
- Ability to respond to film industry requests
- City's role in managing event content (morality police)
- Infrastructure
- Capacity of event organizers



OPPORTUNITIES...

- Establishing an Event & Festival Unit
 - A new model
- Marquee Events
- Signature Festival(s)
- Development of a Filming Policy
 - Collaboration with OK Film Commission to promote Kelowna as a destination
- Opportunity Fund
- Planning initiatives
 - Bernard Ave revit/ Downtown Plan/ Streetscaping
