- 1) Please provide us with the name, address, phone number and email address of the nominated individual. This is necessary if the individual is selected, and is a successful nominee. It is also required if the medal has to be mailed.
- 2) Please confirm that the candidate is a Canadian citizen.
- 3) Does the candidate live in the Thompson-Okanagan-Kootenay region of British Columbia?
- 4) Please provide us with the name, address, phone number and email address of the nominator. (This could be yourself as Mayor or another individual in your district.)
- 5) Please provide us with a brief short statement or summary of your candidate's achievements (in 40 words or 250 characters) along with a longer letter if deemed necessary.

When the submission process is complete, we will notify you if the candidate you nominated has been successful. I encourage you to find out more information on the medal at the Governor General's website www.gg.ca. Thank you for your consideration of my request.
