CITY OF KELOWNA BYLAW NO. 10705

Elected Officials Oath of Office

WHEREAS under Section 120(2) of the *Community Charter*, the Council of the City of Kelowna may, by bylaw, establish an oath or solemn affirmation of office for elected officials;

AND WHEREAS the Council of the City of Kelowna wishes to establish an oath or solemn affirmation of office for City of Kelowna elected or appointed officials;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the City of Kelowna, in open meeting assembled, enacts as follows:

- 1. Pursuant to Section 120 of the *Community Charter*, the oath or solemn affirmation of office for persons selected or appointed to the office of the City of Kelowna Council is as shown in Schedule "A" as attached to and forming part of this bylaw;
- 2. This bylaw may be cited for all purposes as "Elected Officials Oath of Office Bylaw No. 10705".
