1.0 Recommendation

THAT Rezoning Application No. Z12-0050 to amend the City of Kelowna Zoning Bylaw No. 8000, by changing the zoning classification of Lot 1 Section 26 Township 26 ODYD Plan KAP91112, located at 645 Dodd Road, Kelowna, BC, from the P5 - Municipal District Park to the P5 -Municipal District Park (Liquor Primary)zone be considered by Council;

AND THAT the Zone Amending Bylaw be forwarded to a Public Hearing for further consideration;

2.0 Purpose

This application seeks Council's support for a new liquor primary license for Rutland Arena. As the License will be in excess of 100 persons the property must be rezoned concurrently to the 'Liquor Primary' designation.

3.0 Land Use Management

This application is for a new Liquor Primary license for the Rutland Arena. The purpose of the application is to provide spectators the opportunity to consume an alcoholic beverage in the grandstands while watching Junior "B", Okanagan College or adult hockey game (tournaments only). The proposed establishment is in an area where there are currently no other licensed establishments. The proposed liquor service will cater to the local community and support the local Junior "B" hockey team. Liquor service will also be available to adult hockey tournaments, it is anticipated that this will help curb unauthorized drinking in dressing rooms and parking lots.

The proposal is not entirely consistent with Council Policy #359 as it proposes a liquor primary licence in excess of 100 persons and the subject property is not located in an Urban Centre. However, this policy was targeted at private liquor primary establishments and was intended to centralize larger establishments that are open late throughout the week within the City's Urban Centres. While the proposal does contemplate a 450 person capacity license, all alcohol will be served inside the building and alcohol service will be terminated 20 minutes before the end of each Junior "B" game (9:45 end). Alcohol sales will be restricted to beer, wine and coolers. Based on the above, the Land Use Management Department recommends that the application be supported.

4.0 Summary

The purpose of the application is to provide spectators the opportunity to consume an alcoholic beverage in the grandstands while watching Junior "B", Okanagan College or adult hockey game (tournaments only). It is the applicant's intent to have the license in operation only during home games or adult tournaments. House of operation will be sporadic. The license will be operated under a 3rd party agreement by the City of Kelowna's Chiefs Hockey Club. During Junior "B" and college hockey games, a section of the grandstand will be the only licensed area in operation. During adult tournaments, the intent is to use a section of the lobby as a licensed area.



5.0 Existing Policies

5.1 Council Policy #359 - Liquor Licensing Policy & Procedures

The proposal compares to Council Policy #359 as follows:

B. 1. b) Large establishments (with person capacity greater than 249 persons):

- i. Should only be located within an Urban Centre.
 - a. The subject property is not located within an Urban Centre.
- ii. Should be located a minimum of 250m from another Large establishment. a. Satisfied.
- iii. Should be located a minimum of 100m from a Medium establishment.
 - a. Satisfied
- iv. Should not be located beside a Small establishment.
 - a. Satisfied












RUTLAND ARENA 655 DODD ROAD KELOWNA, BC


