Recommendation:

THAT Council receives for information, the Report from the Manager, Real Estate Services dated August 20, 2012, recommending that Council adopt the proposed road closure of a portion of Jenkins Road.

AND THAT Bylaw No. 10726, being proposed road closure of a portion of Jenkins Road, is forwarded for reading consideration.

Purpose:

The excess closed road is to be consolidated with the adjacent parcels in return for a road dedication and an easement.

Background:

Under the terms of an agreement between the City and The Ministry of Transportation and Infrastructure (MoTI) in 2004, MoTI agreed to construct Jenkins Road in the future. Jenkins Road has yet to be constructed by MoTI, and is not completely dedicated at this time.

The City and MoTI have also been working together to achieve the recommendations of the Hwy 97 Access Management Plan (Hwy 97 Plan). One of the Hwy 97 Plan objectives is to eventually reduce the number of accesses from Hwy 97N in favor of access from Jenkins Road.
