## **SUMMARY:**

The Water Service Parcel Tax Bylaw is a bylaw pursuant to Section 360 of the *Local Government Act* to impose and levy a Parcel Tax upon the owners of land or real property within the City of Kelowna capable of being served by the City's water system.

## CITY OF KELOWNA BYLAW NO. 8923

## Water Service Parcel Tax Bylaw

A bylaw pursuant to Section 360 of the *Local Government Act* to impose and levy a Parcel Tax upon the owners of land or real property within the City of Kelowna (hereinafter called "City") capable of being served by the City's water system.

NOW THEREFORE, the Municipal Council of the City of Kelowna, in open meeting assembled, enacts as follows:

- 1. A Parcel Tax shall be and is hereby imposed and levied upon the owners of land or real property within the City of Kelowna capable of being served by the City's water system.
- 2. The Parcel Tax shall be levied in each year on each parcel of land aforementioned, and the amount of such Parcel Tax shall be Fifty Dollars (\$50.00).
- 3. The Parcel Tax shall be in force until the complete discharge and satisfaction by the City of all obligations presently incurred and to be incurred in respect of provision of the City's water system.
- 4. "Water Service Parcel Tax Bylaw No. 8301" is hereby repealed.
- 5. This bylaw shall come into full force and effect and be binding on all persons for the 2003 tax year and each subsequent year thereafter.

Read a first, second and third time by the Municipal Council this 21st day of October, 2002.
